- Camps, Youth, Right Relations, Indigenous Justice, Affirm work (each region is to do the work of becoming an Affirming Region), Mission Support Grants (for now this work will be referred to the HF Executive), Social Justice

Kim discussed the difference between a Committee and a Commission:
