## Name

- 2) Past lay Chairs of Erie, Great Lakes Waterways, Halton, Hamilton and Niagara Presbyteries;
- 3) Retired DLM who retired from a position within the bounds of the region and who are connected to a community of faith within the region

to serve as members of the regional council in additional to the representatives from their home community of faith.

It was also agreed that there would be further discussion re the engagement of youth and young adults in the regional council.

Plans for the March 2<sup>nd</sup> regional gathering were discussed. Robert Lawson, Christina Paradela and Sybil Wilson agreed to assist with the planning.
